Sub: Request to ban the Teacher Education Degrees of Andhra University and Acharya Nagarjuna University- Regarding



Sir,

In inviting a reference to the grievance petition received from you, I am directed to state that, there is no provision of law to declare certificates granted by different universities as invalid unless it is forged. Besides, candidates coming with certificates of any universities viz. either Andhra University or Acharya Nagarjuna University are required to appear and qualify in Odisha Teachers' Eligibility Test (OTET) to teach at elementary level or Odisha Secondary School Teachers' Eligibility Test (OSSTET) to teach at secondary level to work as teacher.


